#### Drive-Thru Medication & Sharps Collection on Saturday, April 24



HC DrugFree will hold our next drive-thru medication and sharps collection on Saturday, April 24 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the **Wilde Lake Village Center parking lot**.

We want your expired and unwanted prescription and over-the-counter medications and your sharps (needles, syringes and EpiPens).

The medication will be guarded and transported by the Howard County Police and the Drug Enforcement Administration. Funding provided by the Howard County Health Department, MDH and SAMHSA. Thank you to everyone partnering with us!

All adult volunteers may <u>register through this link</u>. Feel free to bring a lawn chair if you can't stand (or if you just want to relax) while holding a sign or arrow. Help spread the word that medically-trained adult volunteers are needed to assist with handling the medication and sharps.

Masks will be worn and social distancing will be required, sovolunteer to help a good cause, enjoy the spring weather, and join HC DrugFree's team!

#### What Happens After 4:20 p.m. on 4/20?

April 20, also known as 420, 4:20 or 4/20 (pronounced four-twenty), is a day popular with many <u>marijuana</u> smokers who see it as a "national holiday" of sorts and celebrate by getting high especially around 4:20 p.m.

According to a 2018 report shared by the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), deadly car crashes were 12 percent higher on April 20 after 4:20 p.m. compared to numbers a week before and a week after. For drivers under 21, the crashes were 38 percent higher. <u>Learn more.</u>
